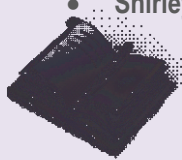


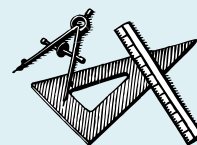
Communication and Language / Literacy

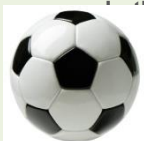
Mathematics
