It is paramount that cars leave the yellow zig zag lines clear outside school. They are there to keep the area outside school safe.

There have also been occasions recently where staff have needed to leave the car park and have been unable to do so as parent vehicles have been blocking the gates. This is unacceptable. The gates must be kept clear in event of an emergency where an emergency vehicle may need to gain access to the site.

Local police are aware of the issues we are having and will be patrolling the area and issuing tickets where parking is illegal. This has already happened at Dordon.

We have an agreement with the Working Men's Club in Wood End that parents can use their car park at the top of Wood Street and walk down to school.

Please make the most of this kind gesture to keep our children safe and the gates clear.

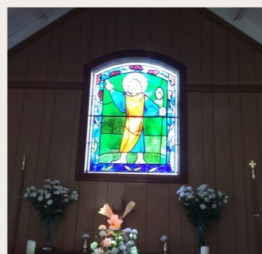
