Manor Adventure Residential Trip Meeting for Parents

As part of the Community Academy Trust, Birchwood, Dordon and Wood End Primary School are increasingly looking for opportunities for schools to work much closer together to benefit all.

Last year Wood End Primary School joined with Birchwood and Dordon Primary Schools in a very enjoyable and successful Year 6 residential visit to 'Manor Adventure'. Again this year, Wood End Primary will also be taking part.

The residential trip will run for 4 days, 3 nights and will take place on Friday 9th June to Monday 12th June 2017.

The venue for the trip will be Manor Adventure at Craven Arms, Shropshire. The site provides premier accommodation for schools in a 90 acre country estate.

The programme for the trip will include 14 of the following activities. The selected activities will be discussed and decided by those children who want to go nearer the time.

The trip will be made up of a total of 14 activities: 2 on the Friday, after arrival, 5 on the Saturday, 5 on the Sunday and 2 more before departure on the Monday. We will also stop off at Telford Town Park for a few hours on our way up to Shropshire on the Friday.

The cost of the trip will be £250 per child. This will cover – travel, food and accommodation, all activities, insurance and entrance fees. There will be no other cost except for a small amount of pocket money.

Payment may be made in installments and cheques should be made payable to Community Academies Trust. In order to secure a place, a non-refundable £50 deposit needs to be paid on Parent Pay by Friday 21st October 2016.
