Over the summer, staff have been busy preparing classrooms and lessons to make sure the children had a super start to the academic year. I was very proud of the way all pupils came back into school. It was clear they are ready for learning and have the right attitude to help them succeed.

This year at Wood End sees a change from last year, with children being taught in their year groups for maths. We have started a new scheme called 'Maths No Problem' in Y2-6 and 'Mathematics Mastery' in Reception and Y1. This requires pupils to be taught in year groups. As a result of our close work with Dordon, we have been able to 'borrow' Mrs Hopkins- the maths leader – to come and deliver lessons in the morning. This also means that Years 1-4 are also taught in their year groups for English. This should support all pupils in making expected progress this year and achieve age related expectations.

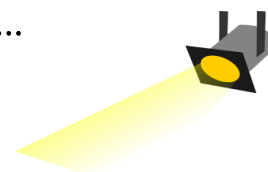

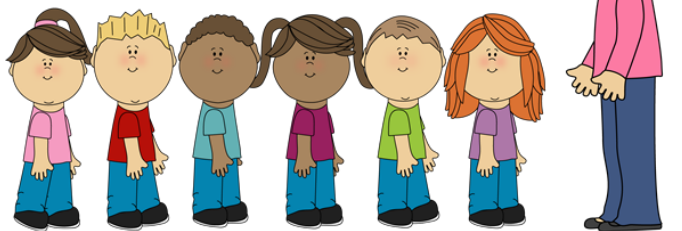
