As I have shared in the past, we monitor attendance and lateness on a weekly basis at Wood End. A short time ago I reported that the level of lateness in school was unacceptable, with too many children being late on too many occasions.

I am writing today to say thank you. As a result of your efforts, the number of lates across school this term is 73 which is an improvement on the previous lateness rate shared at the start of this term. This has a positive impact on your children and the start of the day across school. Where there are still unacceptable levels of lateness, letters have been sent to notify parents.

As with all things at Wood End, if you are finding getting to school on time difficult or there are reasons for poor attendance, please speak to someone in school. We can then arrange a meeting with either Mrs Smith or Miss Lewis to signpost support and put actions in place together to help the situation improve.

Attendance remains a whole school issue and we will continue to monitor this and address issues arising this term.

Last Friday, Wood End hosted the Science Extravaganza event where teachers, children and parents could celebrate British Science Week exploring science, technology, engineering and maths.

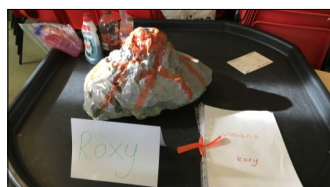
